FEES	New Student Application Fee	\$75 per student payable upon submission of application <i>Non-refundable, one-time fee</i>
	Family Enrollment Fee <i>Non-refundable annual fee</i>	\$375 per family, payable upon submission of enrollment packet OR \$150 per family if oldest child is in half-day or TTh full-day preschool.

*Enrollment fee will hold your spot until Payment #1 is received. Payment #1 is invoiced in May and due June 1 (or upon Acceptance thereafter). Once billed via email, you are financially responsible for Payment #1 (non-refundable & nontransferable). To be released of your financial obligation for Payment #1, a written Notice of Withdrawal is required by May 1st. Families withdrawing after May 1st remain financially responsible for Payment #1.

**To secure the pre-paid rate, ECS must receive a \$300 or more prepayment and maintain a credit on the Enrichment account.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TUITION SCHEDULES AVAILABLE UPON REQUEST

- **Administration** The annual cost of education is determined annually by the ECS School Board. Tuition is divided into ten equal payments per school year (unless another arrangement is made with the finance office) and is paid one month in advance. There is no discount for paying for the entire ten months' tuition in advance. All invoices are emailed unless requested otherwise. There are no tuition reductions for absences due to illness or vacations of any length.

- **Other fees** may be requested to help cover the cost of field trips, class projects, etc. Middle School electives, such as band and art, may also have reasonable fees associated with them. Other *optional* expenses include hot lunch, school pictures, yearbooks, before- and after-school enrichment classes, and sports.

- **Re-Enrollment Fees:** Your account must be current in order to confirm re-enrollment for the upcoming school year. If a re-enrolled family's "Payment #1" for the next school year has not been received by June 10, ECS cannot guarantee enrollment. Once re-enrolled, you are financially responsible for next year's tuition. **To be released of this obligation, a written Notice of Withdrawal must be received by May 1. If received after May 1, Payment #1 will still be due.**

- **Withdrawing—One month's notice is required**, using the **Notice of Withdrawal Form** available in the office. Without 30 days written notice, you will still be required to pay for the upcoming month's tuition.

- **Transfer Students who start on or after the 15th** of a month will be charged one-half the tuition for that month. Students who transfer on or after February 1 and re-register with payment for the upcoming school year will pay only one registration fee for both school years.

- **Preschool Class Change Fee** is \$50 for each occurrence and must be submitted on the **Preschool Class Change Request Form**.

- **Property and/or campus damage (accidental or intentional) - It is the responsibility of the family involved to make proper restitution for damages.**

- **Late Student Pick Up Fee - \$1 per minute** after a 10-minute grace period following the dismissal or closing time

- **Late Payment Fee - \$25** after the 10th of the month

- **NSF Fee - \$30** assessed for ANY check paid to ECS that is returned "Not Sufficient Funds"

- **Failure to pay past due accounts:** After 30 days, the account may go to a collections agency. Any fees, including attorney fees, will be the responsibility of parents/guardians. School policy states that dismissal may result if payment arrangements are not made within thirty days of the account becoming delinquent. Additionally, the withholding from parents and/or requesting schools of report cards, diplomas, test scores, and any other student records will result from an unpaid account balance and will only be made available upon full and final payment.

- **Unmet Volunteer Hours - \$30/Hour** Each full-time preschool through 8th-grade family (based on the oldest student) is asked to volunteer 30 hours per school year. Unmet hours will be billed in May at \$30/hour and are reversible if additional hours are subsequently reported. Part-time preschool families are asked to fulfill the following hours based on number of days in attendance: 2 mornings/week = 6 hrs, 3 morns = 9 hrs, 4 morns = 12 hrs, 5 morns = 15 hrs; 2 full days/wk = 12 hrs; 3 full days/wk = 18 hrs.
