COVID-19 PROTOCOLS & PROCEDURES

ISOLATION

- **If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms, please keep your child home** and follow the current [Washington State DOH COVID-19 Symptom Decision Tree](#) to determine when your child may return to school. ECS requires a negative antigen test result on day 5 to return with symptom onset or positive test date as day 0.
 - ✓ Fever (100.4°F / 38°C or higher)
 - ✓ Chills
 - ✓ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - ✓ Muscle or body aches
 - ✓ New loss of taste or smell
 - ✓ Cough (new, changed, or worsening)
 - ✓ Congestion or runny nose
 - ✓ Nausea or vomiting
 - ✓ Diarrhea
 - ✓ Headache
 - ✓ Fatigue
 - ✓ Sore throat

QUARANTINE

- **If your child is a close contact of someone with COVID-19 and is vaccinated or had COVID-19 in the past 90 days**, they may remain in school and do not need to quarantine if no symptoms have developed. If any symptoms develop, please keep your child home and get tested.
- **If your child is a close contact of someone with COVID-19 and is unvaccinated**, they are eligible to participate in the Test to Stay Program. They may remain in school if they are tested twice during the 5-day quarantine period and if no symptoms have developed.
- **If your child is a close contact of someone from the same household**, regardless of vaccination status, quarantine is required during positive household member's isolation period (5 days). Get tested on day 5. If test result is negative, your child can return to school. If test result is positive, follow the isolation protocol for testing positive.

TRAVEL

- **If you travel out-of-state by private car**, you do not need to quarantine.
- **If you travel by public transportation (bus, plane, train, etc.)**, please follow the recommended "After Travel" CDC guidelines for [domestic](#) and "After Arrival in United States" for [international](#) travel.
