## COVID-19 PROTOCOLS & PROCEDURES

### ISOLATION

- **If your child is experiencing any of the following symptoms, please keep your child home** and follow the current [Washington State DOH COVID-19 Symptom Decision Tree](#) to determine when your child may return to school. ECS requires a negative antigen test result to return on day 6 with symptom onset or positive test date as day 0.
  - ✓ Fever (100.4°F / 38°C or higher)
  - ✓ Chills
  - ✓ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - ✓ Muscle or body aches
  - ✓ New loss of taste or smell
  - ✓ Cough (new, changed, or worsening)
  - ✓ Congestion or runny nose
  - ✓ Nausea or vomiting
  - ✓ Diarrhea
  - ✓ Headache
  - ✓ Fatigue
  - ✓ Sore throat

### CLOSE CONTACT

- **Close contacts can continue to attend school** if they do not develop any symptoms within 10 days of exposure.
- **Regardless of vaccination status, the following guidelines are recommended:**
  - Monitor for symptoms for 10 days after exposure.
  - Consider wearing a well-fitting mask for 10 days after exposure.
  - Consider getting tested 3 to 5 days after exposure.
