- Enrolled families are financially responsible for Payment #1, unless a written Notice of Withdrawal is submitted by <u>May 1</u>.
- Tuition Payment #1 will be withdrawn from your FACTS account on your June payment date (or upon acceptance thereafter).

The annual cost of education is determined annually by the ECS School Board. Tuition is divided into ten equal payments per school year (unless another arrangement is made with the Finance office) and is paid three months in advance. There is no discount for paying the entire tuition in advance. There is no tuition reduction for absences due to illness or vacations of any length.

ECS uses a tuition-remittance program called FACTS for tuition and fee payments. Tuition payments are automatically withdrawn during the first 10 days of the month.

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ALL TUITION IS NON-REFUNDABLE & NON-TRANSFERABLE

- An Activity Fee will be charged to cover the cost of field trips, class projects, class supplies, retreats, etc. in the amount of \$150/year per K-5th grade student and \$250/year per 6th-8th grade student. Other optional expenses may include hot lunch, Enrichment classes, after-school care, athletics, etc.
- Reenrollment: A family's account must be current in order to confirm re-enrollment for the following school year.

 Once reenrolled, the family is financially responsible for Tuition Payment #I for the following year (unless a Notice of Withdrawal is received by May I). If Payment #I is not received by June 10, ECS cannot guarantee enrollment.
- Withdrawal Policy: To withdraw, parents must submit a Notice of Withdrawal (available from the ECS office). Any tuition and fees already paid are non-refundable.
- Transfer Students who start on or after the 15th of a month will be charged one-half the tuition payment for that month. If the student's first month of enrollment consists of four or fewer school days, then tuition will be waived for that month. Students who transfer on or after Feb. I and reenroll for the upcoming school year will pay only one family enrollment fee for both school years.
- Property and/or campus damage (accidental or intentional) It is the responsibility of the family involved to make proper restitution for damages.
- ·Late Student Pick Up Fee \$1 per minute after closing time
- ·Late Payment Fee \$35 after the 10th of the month, in addition to a minimum FACTS fee of \$30.
- ·NSF Fee \$35 assessed for ANY check paid to ECS that is returned "Not Sufficient Funds"
- Failure to pay past due accounts: If payment arrangements are not made within 30 days of an account becoming delinquent, student enrollment may be cancelled and student records withheld from parents and requesting schools until full payment is made. If necessary, the account may be referred to a collections agency.
- Unmet Volunteer Hours \$30/Hour Every family with a full-time student is asked to volunteer 30 hours per school year. Unmet hours will be billed in May at \$30/hour but are reversible if additional hours are reported by June 30.
- ·Annual Financial Statement is available upon request from the Finance Department.
